PERFORMANCE WORKSHOP

DRIVES and MOTIVATION for ALL DOG SPORTS

Denise Fenzi has been training, competing, and titling dogs in obedience, tracking, agility, herding, conformation, and schutzhund for 25 years. Her Belgian Tervuren's score in the high 190's in AKC obedience and high 90's in schutzhund. She is currently trialing with OTCH "Raika" Schh2 UDX TD and "Cisu" Schh3 FH UDX TD.

In *Drives and Motivation for All DOG Sports*, Denise will explain the basic drives used in dog training and how to build them to a level that they can be used in training. Playing tug is discussed extensively. The discussion continues from drives to developing focus in a competition dog, with an emphasis on reading and reacting to your dog's emotional state. Strategies for overcoming stress in the competition dog will be discussed extensively, along with techniques for working with fearful or reactive dogs. Obedience examples may be used but will not be practiced by participants. Working time will be spent developing play skills and learning games for increased focus and interaction with your dog. All techniques are play-based and fun. This seminar is heavy on lecture and discussion. Working time is mainly in groups with one-on-one feedback from Denise to improve your techniques and help you better understand your dog. This seminar is popular with obedience and agility competitors in particular who wish to build drive, focus and play in their dogs.

This seminar is limited to 15 working spots. If you have a working spot you can bring 2 dogs and alternate them but can only work 1 dog per exercise.

Registration is \$225 for working spots if registration is received by March 1, 2012 and \$250 after March 1, 2012. Auditor spots are \$125 if received before March 1, 2012 and \$150 after March 1, 2012. Lunch is included both days. Refunds, less \$30, will be given if request is made prior to June 1, 2012. If working spots are full and we have someone to take your place, we will give a refund after June 1, 2012, of the registration fee less \$30. A working spot is 1 dog per exercise and 1 person. An auditor spot is 1 person. Crating space may be available for non-working dogs. Information will be in the confirmation letter. Multiple family members may get a discount but may not attend without registering unless prior written permission is granted due to unusual circumstances. If you switch or sell your spot you must notify us at fundogs@gmail.com at least 24 hours prior to the seminar with the name of the person taking your place.

Information regarding motels, location, directions, times, food/drinks and other details will be provided in your confirmation letter, which will be sent (by email if provided on your registration) app. 4 weeks before the seminar.
