Constitution

## ARTICLE I

## 罢躇e and Objectives

SECTIOD 1. The name of the Club shall be Durham Kennel Clut, Inc.
SECTIOE 2. The objects of the Club shall be:
(a) to further the advancement of all breeds of pure-bred dogs;
(b) to do all in it's pover to protect and advance the interests of all breeds of pure-bred dogs and to encourage sportswan like competition at dog shous and obedience trials;
(c) te conduct sanctioned matches, dog shous, and obedience trials under the rules of the famican Kennel Club.

SECTION 3. The club shall not be conducted or operated for a profit and no part of any profits of rewainders of residues frow duas of donations to the Club shall inure to the benefit of any menter or individual.

SECTION 4. The menbers of the club shayl adopt and may from time to time revise such by-laus as way be required to carry out these objectives.

## BY-LAMS

ARTICLE I

Kembership

Section i. Eligibility. There shall be four types of mentership, Junior Kemberstip, Associate Membershipy Regular Memership, and Honorary-Life liemership. Associate and Regular nembership is open to persons eighteen years of age and older who are in good standing with the finerican Kennel Club and who subscribe to the purpose of this Club.

Associate membership: Assaciate Nembership is open to neucomers to the Club and to persons whese mewhership has been terninated by expulsion (Article UI). Duration of such wembership shall not be less than six wonths nor more then twelve months. After six months, an fssociate Member way aply for regular qegular Menbership. All privileges of the Club, vith the exception of voting and holding elective office, are avallable to Associate Nembers.

Regular Mextership: Upon adoption of these by-laus, all members in good standing as of that date shall become Regular Members of the Club. Any person who at any time prior to the adoption of these
by-laus uas aber of the Club and whe membership was terinated by weans other than expulsion way, by paying the menbership dues and submitting application for membership, become a Regular Hewber of the Club, All other persons uishing ta becone Regular Kembers must waintain satisfactory Assotiate lembership for a period of not less than six months betore applying for Regular hembership. All privileges of the Clut are available to Regular hembers.

Junior fendership: dunior hemership is open to persons under the age of eighteen years of age uho are in good thanding uith the feerican kempe Club and whe sutscribe to the purpose of this clut. All privileges et the Club, with the exception of holding elective office and voting, are available to Junior benbers.

Honorary - Life henbership: Honorary - Life Membershif is to be conferred on special members of the club as recognition of special contributions to the club by those individuals. Rames of candidates for this honor mey bs proposed by the Board of Directors or submitted to the secretary in uriting for consideration the soard of Directors. The Board shall consider these petitions at its next regular metimg. Ehall sublt ifs recommendations to the pembership for wote pithin three months of the dets wh the petition was received by the secretary. Honorary-Life flemers have all the rights and pritileges of a regular mender. Honorary-Life Nembers shall not be required to pay anmal dues.

While memberstip is to be uncstricted as to residence, the club's primary purpose is to represent the breeders and exhibitors in the imediate ares.

Section 2: Dues, Nembership Dues shall be as follous:


Membership dues are payatle on or before the first day of vanuary of each Year R Regular hewars joining the Club after septater 1 shall pay one talf of the annual dues for that year. Wo Regular Nember may vote uhose dues are not paid tor the current year. During the minth of November, the Treasurer shall send to each werer a statement of dues for the ensuing year.
 by the buart :rector: and wich shall provide that the applicant agees te abide ty these constitutson ans by-laus and the rules of The ferican Kennel Club. The application shall state the Bame, adoress, and occupation of the applicant and it shall carry the endorsement of tyo anemers. Accompanying the application, the prespective wember shall subit dues payment for the current year. hll applications are to fo filed vith the secretary and each application is to be read at the first meeting of the Club tolloing its receipt. At the next club meting the application uill be voted upon and affirmative vote of $3 / 4$ of the mers present and voting at that weting shall be required to elect the applicant.

Applications for mbership uho have been rejected by the club way not re-apply uithin six months after such rejection.

SECTIO 4. Terwination of Wefobship. Nenbership was be ternimatedx
(a) by resignation. Any menter in good standing may resign from the Club upon uritten notice to the fecretary: but no menter may resign when in fobt te the Club. Dues obligations are considered a debt to the club and they becole imcurred on the first day of each fiscal year.
(b) by lapsing. $\quad$ medership vill be considered as lapsed and autowatically tereinated if such蹗meres dues rean unpaid 90 days after the first day of the fiscal year, houever, the Board way grant an additional 90 days of grace to such delinquent members in meritorious cases. in no case
way a person be entitled to vote at any Club eeting uhose dues are unpaid as of the date of that此eting．
（c）by expulsion．$\cap$ mership nay $^{2}$ be terwinated by expulsion as provided in Article UI of these by－ lavs．
article II

Heetings and Voting

SECTIOR 1．Club Heetings．Heetings of the Club shall be held in（or vithin 25 wiles of）the City of Durham，在．C．on the third Monday of each month，uith the exceptions of July and August，at such hour and place as may be designated by the Board of Directors．Hritten notice of each such meeting shall be malled by the Secretary at least 10 days prior to the date of the meeting．For the purpose of conducting business，the quorum for such meetings shall be at least $15 \%$ of the Regular Hembers in good standing．

SECTION 2．Special Club heetings．Special Club meetings way be called by the President，or by a majority vote of the wembers of the Board uho are present and voting at any regular or special
 members of the Club uho are in good standirg．Such special meetings shall be held in（or uithin 25 wiles of）the City of Durham at such place，date，and hour as may be designated by the person or persons authorized herein to call such meetings．Uritten notice of such a meeting shall be wailed by the Secretary at least 5 days and not wore than 15 days prior to the date of the weeting，and said notice shall state the purpose of the meeting，and no other club business way be transacted thereat．The quorum for such a meeting shall be $15 \%$ of the Regular nembers in good standing．

SECTION 3．Board Heetings．The Board of Directors shall hold metings during the wenths of February，April，August，September，買owedber，and December each year vithin 25 酮les of the City of Durham at such times and places as way be designated by the Board．Written notice of each such weetirg shall be wailed by the Secretary at least 5 days prior the the date of the meeting．The quorum for such a meting shall be a majority of the Board．

SECTIOR 4．Special Board Meetings．Special metings of the Board may be called by the President， and shall be called by the secretary upon receipt of a uritten request signed by at least three members of the Board：Such special meetings shall be held in（or vithin 25 制iles of the city of Durham at such place，date，and hour as may be designated by the person authorized herein to call such weting．Hritten notice of such meeting shall be mailed by the Secretary at least 5 days and not wore than 10 days prior to the date of the meeting，or telegraphic notice shall be filed at least 3 days and not more than 5 days prior to the date of the $\begin{aligned} & \text { meting．Any such notice shall state }\end{aligned}$ the purpose of the meeting and no other business shall be transacted thereat．a quoru for such a meeting shall be a majority of the Board．

SECTIOR 5．Voting．Each Regular Hember in good standing whose dues are paid for the current year shall be entitled to one vote at any meting of the clut at which he is present．Proxy voting uill not be permitted at any club weeting or election．

## ARTICLE III

## Directors and Officers

SECTIOL 1．Board of Directors．The Board shall be comprised of the President，Vice－President， Secretary，Treasurer，and（ifive）other persons all of uhom shall be Regular Members in good standing and all of whom shall be elected for one－year ter ats the Club＇s annual meting as provided in Article IV and shall serve until their successors are elected．General management of the Club＇s affairs shall be entrusted to the Board of Directers．

SECIIOD 2．Officers．The Club＇s officers，consisting of the President，Vice－President，Secretary，
and Treasurer shall serve in their respective capacities both with regard to the Club and its meetings and the Board and its meetings.
(a) The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club and of the Board, and shall have the duties and pouers normally appurtenant to the office of President in addition to those particularly specified in these by-laus.
(b) The Vice-President shall have the duties and exercise the pouers of the President in case of the President's death, absence, or incapacity.
(c) The Secretary shall keep a recerd of all meetings of the club and of the Board and of all watters of which a record shall be ordered by the Club. He shall have charge of the correspondence, notify members of meetings, notify nev menters of their election to membershipy notify officers and directors of their election to office, keep a roll of the members of the club uith their addresses, and carry out such other duties as are prescribed in these by-laus.
(d) The Treasurer shall collect and receive all wonies due or belonging to the club. He shall depesit the same in a bank designated by the Board, in the name of the Club. His books shall at all times be open to inspection of the Board and he shall report to the at every weeting the condition of the Club's finances and every item of receipt or pasment not before reported; and at the annual meeting he shall render an account of all monies received and expended during the previous fiscal year. The Treasurer shall be bonded in such amount as the Board of Directors shall deterwine.

SECTION 3. Vacancies. Any vacancies occurring on the Board or among the officers during the year shall be filled until the next annual election by a wajority vote of all the then members of the Board at its first regular meeting follouing the creation of such vacancy, or at a special Board lleeting called for that purpose: except that a vacancy in the office of President shall be filled automatically by the Vice-President and the resulting vacancy in the office of Vice-President shall be filled by the Board.

## ARTICLE IV

## The Club Year, Annusl heeting, Elections

SECTIOL 1. Club Year. The Club's fiscal year shall begin on the 1 st day of June and end on the 31 st. day of hay.

The Club"s official year shall begin imediately at the conclusion of the election at the annual weeting and shall continue through the election at the next annual meeting.

SECTIOR 2. Annual Meeting. The ammal meeting shall be held in the month of May at uhich officers, Delegate to The fomerical Kemel Clut, and Directors for the ensuing year shall be elected by secret, uritten ballot from among those nominated in accordance vith section 4 of the Article. They shall take office imediately upon the conclusion of the election and each retiring officer shall turn over to his successor in office all properties and records relating to that office uithin 30 days after the election.

SECTIOM 3. Elections. The nominated candidate receiving the greatest momer of votes for each office shall be declared elected. The five noninated candidates for other positions on the Board who receive the greatest number of votes for such positions shall be declared elected.

SECIIOR 4. 置㽤inations. Wo person way be a candidate in a club election uho has not been nominated. During the month of December the Board shall select a mominating Comittee consisting of three menbers and tuo alternates, not wore than one of uhom shall be a member of the Board. The Secretary shall immediately notify the comentteenen and alternates of their selection. The Board shall name a Chairman for the Comittee and it shall be his duty to call a comittee weeting uhich shall be held on or before Fetruary $15 t$.
（a）The Comittee shall nowinate one candidate for each office and for Delegate to the American Kennel Club，who way but need not be，an officer or directer of the club，and five other positions of the Board，and，after securing the consent of each person 50 nowinated，shall inmediately report their nominations to the Secretary in uriting．
（b）Upon receipt of the 買盢ination Comittee＇s report，the Secretary shall before February i5 th notify each member in uriting of the candidates 50 nowinated．
（c）Additional nominations may be wade at the April meeting by any member in attendance provided that the person 50 nowinated does not decline when his name is proposed，and provided further that if the proposed candidate is not in attendance at this eeeting，his proposer shall present to the Secretary a uritten statement from the proposed candidate signifying his uillingness to be a candidate．Except for the position of Delegate to the fmerican kennel Club，no person way be a candidate for more than one position，and the additional nowinations uhich are provided fore herein may be wade only from anong those menters who have not accepted a nomination of the lowinating Comittee．
（d）買owinations cannot be wade at the annual aeting or in any manner other than as provided in this Section．

## ARTICLE V

Comittees

SECIION 1．The Board may each year appoint standing colmittees to advance the vork of the Club in such matters as dog shous，obedience trials，trophies，annual prizes，wembership，and other tields uhich may vell be served by conittees．Such committees shall alvays be subject to the final authority of the Board．Special committees way also be appointed by the Board to aid it on particular projects．
 the Board upon uritten notice to the appointee：and the Board way appoint successors to those persons whose services have been terwinated．

## ARTICLE UI

## Discipline

SECTION 1．American Kennel Club Suspension．Any member who is suspended fromprivileges of The American kennel Club autmatically shall be suspended form privileges of this Club for a like period．

SECTION 2．Charges，Any member may prefer charges against a member for alleged misconduct prejudicial to the best interests of the club．Hritten charges uith specifications eust be filed in duplicate uith the secretary vith a deposit of $\$ 10.00$ which shall be forfeited if such charges are not sustained by the Board following a hearing．The Secretary shall promptly send a copy of the charges to each member of the Board or present them at a Board Heeting，and the Board shall first consider whether the actions alleged in the charges，if proven，wight constitute a conduct prejudicial to the best interests of the club．If the Board entertains jurisdiction of the charges it shall fix a date of a hearing by the Board not less than 3 ueeks thereafter．The Secretary shall promptly send one copy of the charges to the accused menber by registered wail together vith notice of the hearing and an assurance the the defendant may personally appear in his oun defense and bring vitnesses if he uishes．

SECIIOH 3．Board Hearing．The Board shall have complete authority to decide whether counsel may attend the hearing，but both conplainant and defendant shall be treated uniforinly in that regard． Should the charges be sustained，after hearing all the evidence and testimony presented by complainant and defendant，the Board way by a wajority yote of those present suspend the defendant

Irom all privileges of the Club for not more than six months from the date of the hearing. And, if if deems that punishment insufficient, it walso recomend to the membership that the penalty be expulsion. In such case, the suspension shall not restrict the defendant's right to appear before his fellou-members at the ensuing Club meeting uhich considers the Board's recomendation. I mediately after the Board has reached a decision, its findings shall te put in uritten form and filed with the Secretary. The Secretary, in turn, shall notify each of the parties of the Board's decision and penalty, if any.

SECTIO 4. Expulsion. Expulsion of a member fro the Clut may be accomplished only at a meeting of the Club folloving a Board hearing and upon the Board's recomendation as provided in Section 3 of this Article. Such proceedings 嘼y occur at a regular or special eeting of the Club to be beld within 60 days but not earbier than 30 days after the date of the Board's recommendation of expulsion. The defendant shall have the privilege of appearing in his oun behalf, though no evidence shall be taken at this weeting. The President shall read the charges and the Board's findings and recomendations, and shall invite the defendant, if present, to spak in his oun behalf if he vishes The meeting shall then vote by secret ballot on the proposed expulsion. a $2 / 3$ vote of those present and voting at the meeting shall be necessary for expulsion. If expulsion is not so voted, the Board's suspension shall stand.

## Article VII

## A開endiaents

 by uritten petition addressed to the Secretary signed by fifteen percent of the membership in good standing. Amendments proposed by such petition shall be promptly considered by the board of Directors and wast be sulditted to the members with recomendations of the board by the secretary for a vote within three months of the date when the petition uas received by the secretary.

SECTIOR 2. The constitution and by-laus way be amended by a $2 / 3$ wote of the members present and voting at the regular or special meeting called for the purpose, provided the proposed amendents have been included in the notice of the meeting.

SECTION 3. To amendent to the constitution and by-laus that is adopted by the club shall become effective until it has been approved by the Board of Directors of The merican Kennel Club.

ARTICLE IX

Dissolution
§ECIIOR 1. Dissolution. The Clut was be dissolved at any time by uritten consent of not less than $2 / 3$ of the menbers. In the event of the dissolution of the clubs uhether voluntary or inwoluntary or by operation of law, none of the property of the club nor any proceeds thereof nor any assets of the Club shall be distributed to any members of the Club but after pajent of the debts of the Club its property and assets shall be given to a charitable organization, for the benefit of dogs, selected by the Board of Directors.

Article IX

## Order of Jusiness

SECTIOR 1: At business meetings of the Club, the order of business, 50 far as the character and nature of the eeting way perwit, shall be as follows:
