Minutes of Meeting, December 17th, 1945

The first meeting of the reactivated Durham Kennel Club, Inc. was held December 17, 1945, at the Forest Hills Club House, in Durham, North Carolina. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. by Mr. C. P. Jones, Acting Chairman. Following a brief discussion of the Charter existing for The Durham Kennel Club, Inc, which had been active prior to 1941, it was voted to use both the name and charter of the previous organization. A vote to void all previously existing Constitution and By-Laws was then passed, and a new Constitution and By-Laws was proposed. After a brief discussion and a few minor alterations, the new Constitution and By-Laws were adopted. This was followed by election of Officers and a Board of Directors, as listed:-
