

January 1948

The Durham Kennel Club met on January 19 at the Forest Hills Club House.

Before the meeting was called to order, Mr. Little, photographer for the paper, took some pictures of the show committee and new officers of the club.

The President called the meeting to order and introduced Dr. Cooper of the County Board of Health, who gave an interesting talk on the control of Rabies in Durham County.

The minutes of the previous meeting and the Board of Directors meeting of January 9 were read and approved.

The treasurer reported \$530.59 in the treasury. This was taking into account the check of Capt. Johnson for \$50.00, which was returned. He only wanted to be reimbursed for his actual expenses in judging in our show last May, which amounted to \$20.00.

Mr. Boone, our Bench Show Chairman, stated that he had just received a letter from Mr. Moss advising him that Mr. Kemp of Enka, N. C. could not judge in our show. He asked, and was granted, the permission of the Club to contact Mr. Weaver and see if he wouldn't judge in Mr. Kemp's place.

Mrs. Hutchings, Chairman of the trophy committee, reported that all the money for the trophies has been subscribed and premium lists have been sent in. They only lack about \$100.00 for local best of Breed. It was decided not to give \$1.00 and \$2.00 prizes in the classes.

Mrs. Bolich reported that she, with the Club's permission, would try to secure the endorsement of the Merchants Association in our advertising for the Dog Show in April.

The Secretary asked that all members pay their dues for the new year and \$21.00 was collected and turned over to Mrs. Hoenig.

The meeting adjourned at 10:45.
