

January, 1949

The Durham Kennel Club met in the Forest Hills Club House on Wednesday, January 19th with 31 members and guests present.

The president called the meeting to order and then turned it over to Mrs. Douglas Hill, the program chairman.

Mrs. Hill read excerpts from the Durham City code, regarding dog laws in the city and pointed out how antiquated the dog laws were. The program was conducted in the form of a forum with Mrs. Hill asking questions and leading the discussion. The special guests taking part in the discussion were Mrs. J. L. VonGlaun, Dr. David Weaver and Mr. Wilkerson from Raleigh and James Deal, the Durham County /Dog Warden.

Mrs. VonGlaun described the Raleigh Animal Shelter and explained how the Raleigh dog code had been rewritten and made practicable. Mr. Deal told us about the new Durham County dog pound under construction on Trinity Road extension and described the methods used in his work.

Mr. Fowler suggested that the club appoint a committee to go before the City Council and suggest changes in the dog ordinance.

After the program the secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting and the treasurer report a balance of \$1409.68. It was also announced that a profit of \$10 was made on the Sanction Match held last October.

Mr. Jones announced that the following judges had been selected for our show; Anton Rost, Col. Glenn Bowsted, Dr. Louis Cornet and Mrs. Florence Hebbel. Confirmation had not been received from the AKC. The secretary read the proposed premium list and the trophy donors.

It was announced that Mr. and Mrs. W. Sanford Corsbie would lead the club's annual show training class starting the last week in February.
