

DURHAM KENNEL CLUB - September 1968 Meeting

The Durham Kennel Club held its monthly meeting on September 16, 1968, at the Forest Hills Club House Shelter. Thirty-six members were present for the covered dish supper and meeting.

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Keith Grimson. Minutes of the May meeting were read by the Secretary and approved as read. The Treasurer's report was incomplete at the time.

2. Obedience: The Obedience Classes were begun on September 10 at the Civic Center with approximately 76 applications received. Mrs. Bullock reiterated about the members paying the full fee for the first class and half the registration for the second class, after which a member could attend any of the classes without charge.
3. Program: Mr. Haines suggested that at our next meeting a discussion with examples of handling canines in the show ring be presented since this meeting would be held just prior to the Sanctioned Match.
4. Publicity: Mr. Haines reported on the Tailwagger Meeting held on July 21 and the decision to continue having these meeting at different areas rather than a set place each time.
5. Breeders Information: Miss Copley collected the information forms that were mailed to the members requesting information on their dogs. This in turn will be mailed to Wilmington for compiling a directory for breeders.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
