

MINUTES OF THE DURHAM KENNEL CLUB MEETING, May 21, 1979

Treasurer Mary Holland reported a total of \$21,724 in all accounts.

Mary will be investing money from the treasury in certificates to gain interest at a rate of 9.6%.

Sue Geesler has agreed to be match chairman for our summer match.

A request has been made that all members be extra careful with the walls in the building; notices may be placed on the bulletin boards or designated areas.

Sharow Sawyer reported that a rumor had reached her that there had never been DKC Board approval for the kitchen and walls in the Clubhouse; she explained that \$1,000 was budgeted for the kitchen, that some money had been donated by individual members for that specific purpose, that some supplies had also been donated, and the balance had come from the match and bake sale. The paneling had been put in place to prevent tearing of the insulation.

Dr. Smith reported that AKC, by telephone, had indicated approval was extremely likely for our show in October to be held in Burlington. The building in Burlington is larger and no problems are anticipated.

Marge White explained that when she asked permission to place an ad for \$25 for the 1979 US Eastern Regional Dog Obedience Championships being held in Lynchburg, Virginia, that the deadline for placing ads had already passed at the time she made the request. For that reason, we will not have an ad this year supporting this event.

Marge announced that the last night for obedience before September would be June 5th in the event someone would like to come out and watch.

Marge also announced that some of our obedience dogs are giving a group demonstration at a school during the last week of school; if anyone is interested in joining or have a demonstration given at their school, please let her know.

Betty Hood, Club Librarian, announced that a book return box would be at future meetings for returning loaned books.

Becky Stanley announced that trophies were needed for group non-sporting and also for high-in-trial in obedience for the fall show. Please see Becky or M. F. Davis about trophies.

Linda Cooke announced that the picnic would be in June --- date to be announced later --- plans are in the works for a puppy match and a gymkhana.
