Kim Reid passed a sign up sheet for cleaning the building.

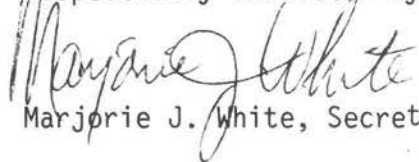
Mary Oppermann reported for Membership: The following have been voted in as regular members:
