Volunteers are needed to provide transportation from and to the airport for the judges and Ann Walthall will need help in providing hospitality for our judges and stewards on the day of the show.


Sharon Pitz reported that T-shirts (\$8.00) and sweatshirts (\$18.00) will be on sale at the catalogue table at our show.
