## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

---

- Due to limited space, no unentered dogs will be allowed in the building.
- Limited crating space will be available for entered dogs.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and themselves in and around the building and parking area.
- Food will be available on the days of the trials.
- Dogs cannot be left in the building overnight.
- **Entry Fees:** \$22.00 for the first entry of a dog and \$18.00 each additional entry of the same dog per trial. An AKC recording fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered in the Obedience trials. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in the Rally trial.
- UDX will be offered as a class. Dogs entered in this UDX Class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or the Utility B Class, the UDX Class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.
- Closing date for entries: 12:00 Noon, Friday, November 25, 2011 at the Trial Secretary's home after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted. Telegraph, emailed, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- Make all checks and money orders payable to: **Durham Kennel Club**. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. A fee of \$20 will be charged for any returned check.
- Any entry sent via express mail or any other similar service must be sent "no signature required".
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- Bitches in season: Bitches that come in season after the closing date of the obedience trial may have all but \$10.00 of the entry fee refunded upon receipt by the trial secretary of a veterinarian certificate prior to the beginning hour of judging.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.
- **CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM** for time of judging. Show hours are Friday 4:30 pm – 10:30 pm, Saturday 6:30 am – 5:00 pm, and Sunday 6:30 am – 5:00 pm.

  - Saturday: Obedience will start at 8:00am.

- Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 16. Move-ups for the Friday Rally trial (2011016116) and Saturday Obedience trial (2011016114) must be made in writing prior to 6 pm Monday, December 12<sup>th</sup>. Move-ups for the Sunday Obedience trial (2011016115) must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the last class finishes for the Saturday Obedience trial (2011016114).
- **JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT** for any dog holding up a class. Owners and Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
