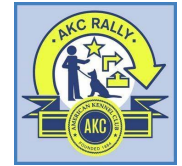

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

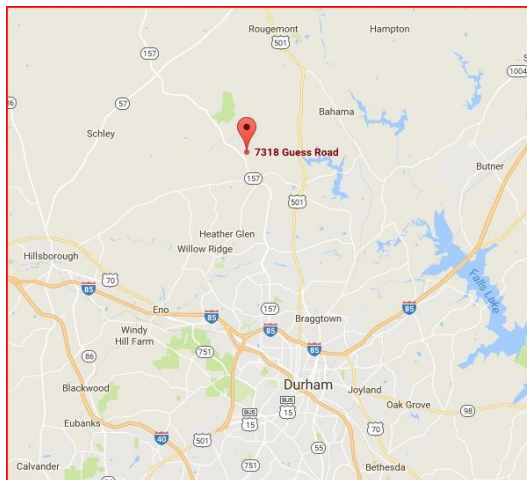

DIRECTIONS TO THE DURHAM KENNEL CLUB

From I-85 North or South, take Guess Road (NC 157) exit off I-85, go approximately 8.5 miles north (away from Durham). The Durham Kennel Club drive is on the right side of the road and is marked by a blue sign. The gravel drive ends at the Durham Kennel Club.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Due to limited space, no unentered dogs will be allowed in the building.

THERE WILL BE NO FOOD AVAILABLE AT THESE TRIALS.

Limited crating space will be available for entered dogs. Dogs cannot be left in building overnight.

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and themselves in and around the building and parking area.

Entry Fees: \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog and \$23.00 each additional entry of the same dog in the same trial. An AKC recording fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered in each of the Rally trials.

A wait list will be maintained in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 27 in order to fill openings created by withdrawals before closing. Wait list will be held open until five days before trial. An hour of judging will be held until March 10 2022 for entries via USPS. After March 10 2022, the trial will be filled with entries in the order in which they were received.

Closing date for entries: 5 pm, Wednesday, May 5 2021 at the Trial Secretary's office after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted. Telegraph, emailed, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. One hour or judging will be reserved until March 10 for entries via USPS after which entries will revert to first received.**

By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. If you would like your confirmation letter and judging program sent via US Postal Service, you may either not provide your email address on your entry or you may specifically request USPS.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Bitches that come in season after the closing date of the trial may have all but \$5 of the entry fee refunded.

It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form.

In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 16. Transfers must be submitted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial for which the transfer is being requested.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. Owners and Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those in-volved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsman-ship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- ◇ Sportsmen respect this history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs
- ◇ Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition as well as winning and losing with grace.
- ◇ Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behaviour.
- ◇ The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- ◇ The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- ◇ The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placement could be biased on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- ◇ The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- ◇ The sportsman respects AKC ByLaws, rules, regulations, and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- ◇ Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- ◇ Sportsmen welcome, encourage, and support newcomers to the sport.
- ◇ Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- ◇ Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- ◇ Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- ◇ Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club or themselves while taking part in the sport.
