Entries will be drawn: 6:00pm Sunday January 18, 2026 at the home of the secretary, public is invited. The drawing will be at random among all entries received except that preference will be given to untitled dogs. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn, subject to the same preferences set forth above.

Entrants will be contacted by email between 6:30 – 8:00 PM EST Monday, January 19, 2026. All those submitting entries (or their designated agent) will be sent an email and . A judging program will be sent to entrants and alternates following the drawing for entries.

If an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine whether any alternates are present. If so, spaces will be filled by such alternates, in the order in which they were drawn, giving preference to untitled dogs.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Errors on Entry Blanks: **Owners are responsible for errors in making out forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.**

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under the "AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines". I (we) agree that the club holding this show, obedience trial and/or agility trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in the show's premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
